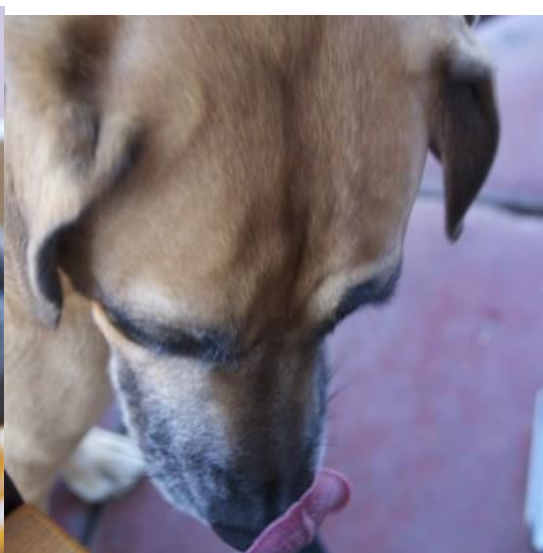
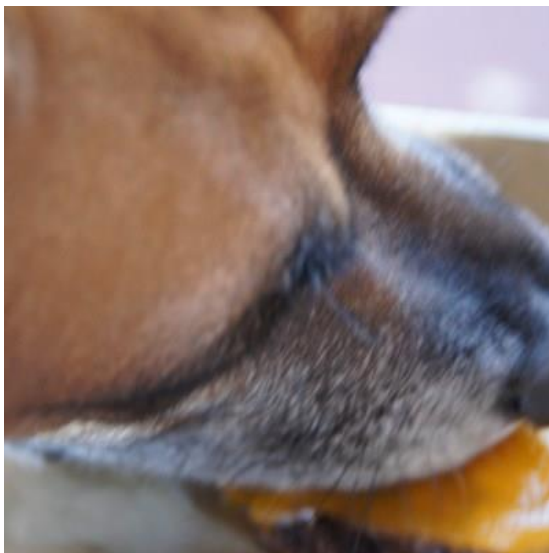
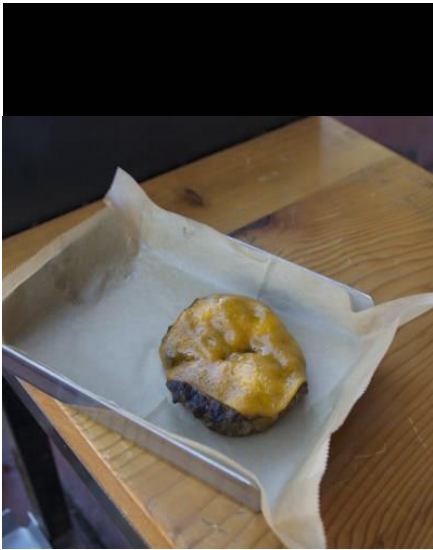

We recently paid Encontro a visit to get a sneak peak of their new dog menu, with Java. Java is a lab boxer mix, emphasis on the lab portion. She is as food oriented as they get. Being the food connoisseur she is, she was the perfect judge for what Encontro will be serving up to all the neighborhood pooches. Her three-course meal consisted of a **Hot-Diggity-Dog**, a **Mutt Melt**, and a **Peanut Butter Cheddar Biscuit**. She gobbled them up, with not a crumb leftover. Meanwhile, we sipped on **32 North's Encontro Blonde with White Peaches**. On a hot day, this beer had the perfect combination of biscuity malts with a medium to full body, and some subtle not-too-sweet peach notes. This is definitely a must have for your next
